## Snippets of Recent Foothills Programs

### September 14 – Ceal Barry, University of Colorado Associate Athletic Director /Academics / Student Services

Former University of Colorado Women's Basketball Coach Ceal Barry spoke to our club members about her many years being involved in CU athletes since her arrival in Boulder in 1983. After leading the Lady Buffs to 427 victories and 12 NCAA post-season tournament appearances, Ceal moved to her current Co-Athletic Director role in 2006, among other things helping athletes to make the transition from collegiate athletics via CU's STEP (Success Training and Exit Program). This program helps athletes to adjust to a non-athletic team environment, evaluates the physical condition of graduating athletes, continues treatment of athletics-related injuries, provides psychological counseling if needed, and helps to plan the financial future for graduated athletes. Ceal also talked about her former women's basketball players, where many of them have gone on to be involved in coaching and other sports-related jobs. Ceal is a wonderful ambassador for the University of Colorado and its Athletics Department.



### September 21 – Kerry Hassler, Foothills Kiwanis Business Meeting to review/sign-up for 2009-2010 Foothills Projects/Activities

Kerry first reviewed with club members a summary of our club's 2008-2009 fundraising results and projects, and then went through a list of our club's 2009-2010 leadership, support team, and club project roles. Club members were asked to volunteer for 2009-2010 not-yet-filled positions, as well as to indicate which club projects they'd be willing to support this next year, such as donating snacks/food coupons to Blue Sky Bridge the first Monday of each month, and volunteering for the Bolder Bolder Security Team, Taste of Downtown Boulder, 4<sup>th</sup> of July donations collection, Salvation Army Bell-Ringing, and other club projects.
