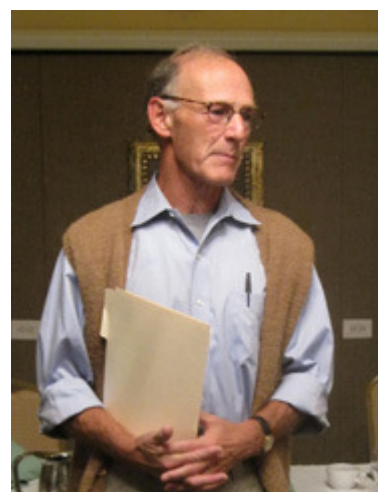

September 10 – Peter Kleinman, “Second Wind Fund of Boulder County”

Mr. Kleinman is a psychiatrist who works with at-risk youth in the Boulder area. After living in Ann Arbor Michigan for many years, Peter returned to Boulder with his wife and works with the Second Wind fund to help teenagers considering suicide. The key aspect in determining if a young person is likely to attempt a suicide is a marked change in behavior, whether that be positive or negative. Peter has witnessed suicidal behavior in all classes of young people, and through the Second Wind Fund of Boulder he hopes to give young people another chance at life. September 17 – Marie Connolly, “Guiding Light LLC”

Marie Connolly is a patient advocate and spoke to our club about the services she provides. A patient advocate looks out for the best interests of an individual who is considering spending time in a hospital. The new health care law passed by congress affects patient care by conducting audit of admissions, meaning that hospitals will be encouraging a minimum three day stay in a hospital. Her primary advice was to not assume that someone is in charge when you are seeking medical assistance at a hospital. Key advice in her talk was 1) Take notes, and have provider write everything down, 2) No advocate is need for a 1-day surgery, 3) Medicare Patients require advocates, 4) It is a good idea to have an advanced directive in case of complications while at a hospital. Very useful information.
