BVSD Volunteer Tutors – we helped students in English and Math.

RSVP (Retired Senior Volunteer Program) – we sponsored RSVP for the first twenty years. We provided volunteers for many programs of RSVP. We picked up assembled Christmas fruit baskets in Denver and delivered them to Boulder, where the members distributed at least 10 to 12 baskets each to needy families in Boulder County. We delivered several hundred each year. We supplied the truck for the pickup in Denver. We provided handyman fixit volunteers. Our members served on the RSVP Board of Directors. We installed grab bars for showers and tubs.

Highway Cleanup - Highway 119 (the diagonal from 63rd to 47th Street) was quite a job because of large median; done twice a year with twenty plus Kiwanians participating. Many weird items were found during the cleanup!

World War II Tapes - various Kiwanians related on tape their experiences in World War II from flying the hump in China (Bob Murphy) to fighting the enemy in the Aleutians (Frank Young) to commanding a phantom division in France through radio transmissions and fake equipment moving in and out of battles to confuse the enemy (Cliff Simenson).

Kellwood Bowling – we took tenants at Kellwood House bowling on monthly basis. Program champion was Cliff Simenson

Alert Service Dogs - program now up to twenty six alert golden retrievers for kids with diabetes. Our first dog was for peanut allergy student. Currently, we train the parents how to train the dogs. We buy the dogs and when the parents complete the training at graduation we give them title to the dogs.

Children’s Hospital KPTI (Kiwanis Pediatric Trauma Institute) – through our heavy support for KPTI, we helped moved the rating up as a #1 trauma center.

Mapleton Hospital - we provided and installed playground equipment at the hospital for their head-trauma children.

Sweet Dream In A Bag – we pack bedding material for foster children at The Salvation Army gym.

4th of July – we manned the gates at Folsom Field for donations before and after the fireworks for next year’s fireworks, and counted the funds after the event.

Our Past Projects – Rudi’s Perspective

Early projects funding was used to supplement our labor. We would not approve funding for projects where our club was not physically involved since we were very short on funds.

Mapleton Park - we started Mapleton Park with handicap trails in what was a former dump site. We named it for former club member, Glen Kepler. We would go each spring and clear the trails and improve. I believe that the City finally took over the maintenance project. It is now called Centennial Park.

Boulder Valley Girls Softball – our club is a longtime supporter of girls’ softball in Boulder. Many of our members served as coaches and umpires while Pete Sprenkle was the driving force for the development of girls’ softball in Boulder. We provided annual spring cleanup of Burke (Pete Sprenkle) Field.

Taste of Downtown Boulder - 12 to 15 restaurants on and near the Boulder Mall gave samples of food in mid-April for \$15. We would get a green card listing the participating restaurants. I would walk down Pearl Street asking CU students if they had their green cards!
