

She informed us that globally, 1 in 4 youth will suffer some type of abuse or maltreatment. A sad fact is that more than 90% of abusers are people children know, love, and trust. She reminded us that all Service Leadership Program (SLP) advisors, including Faculty Advisors and Sponsors, must have Kiwanis



background checks. The background checks cost \$35; our Kiwanis Club will reimburse you if you provide us with a receipt upon completion. Each member should review the handout materials that were sent to our members: Youth Protection Policies & Procedures, Youth Protection HelpLine, Background Checks, and Join the Fight to End Bullying. Thanks, Heidi, for making us aware of policies and best practices for adults working with youth.
