May 6 – Elena & Mia Aranda, AMISTAD and Companeras Program

Our club met at El Centro AMISTAD, located at 2580 Iris Ave. Boulder. The program was hosted by Elena, Companeras Program Director, and her daughter, Mia. The egg bagels and coffee were donated by Reed of Big Dog Bagels in South Boulder. Our club provided the orange juice, rolls, and coffee. Thanks to Reed and Adam for taking care of us. Elena and Mia described two programs: Latino women and youth tracks that focus on the communication gap between the groups. There are numerous educational and spiritual programs given during the week for women that includes health & nutrition, dance & exercise, meditation, yoga, and crafts. Mia leads the youth track to help bring the youth and older communities together, pregnancy, school dropout, and work. This year Amistad is hosting the 7th Women’s Summit at the UMC on the CU campus. The entire family is invited to attend the summit; they expect up to 200 people this year. We toured the new facility that the group moved into recently. It can accommodate many small groups and has a spacious backyard with playground equipment for the children to play. During the meeting, we discussed how sports can help integrate the youth into the school and community. Jim informed us that 350 Latino youth play soccer out of the total 1800 youth involved in the SPARK Program. More information can be found at: www.elcentroamistad.org. May 13 – Rudi Baumann, “Scenes of Moscow-to-St. Petersburg Trip”

Rudi showed club members photos from his September, 2012 Vikings Tour trip by boat from Moscow to St. Petersburg with wife Sharon. This included scenes of the Russian Orthodox cathedrals inside the Moscow Kremlin area; the famous St. Basil Cathedral outside the Kremlin in Red (Beautiful) Square; and of the Bolshoi Ballet Theatre performance of “Swan Lake”. Other Moscow scenes were shown of the St. Sergius of Radonezh monastery, and the “Golden Ring” cities of Uglich and Yaroslav. There were also shots of various cities along the Moscow Canal trip from Moscow to St. Petersburg. After arriving in St. P, there were scenes shown of the legendary Hermitage Museum (“Winter Palace” of the Czars), the Pushkin area and of Catherine’s Palace (“Summer Palace”), St. Isaac’s Cathedral, the Church of the Savior on the Spilled Blood, and the Peter & Paul Fortress. Foothills Bolder Boulder 10K Starting-Line Security Team Update -- Bob Mohling, Starting-Line Project Leader

For the 35th Bolder Boulder 10K Race being held on Memorial Day (Monday, May 27), we have 14 Foothills Kiwanis members and 9 Monarch High School Key Club members who've volunteered for our Starting-Line Security Team. Our club will receive \$20 for each Foothills volunteer that'll be used by our club as designated by our Foothills Board. For Monarch Key Club volunteers, their Key Club will also receive \$20 per volunteer that they'll use for their 2013-2014 Key Club activities and donations. Here are instructions for our team:

- Meet at 6:00 a.m. at the Bolder Boulder volunteer tent located in the breezeway on the south side of Christy Sports (2071 30th St., Boulder).
- Between 6:15-6:30 a.m., our team will get instructions about what we'll be doing to help start the race from Security Team Leader Fred Fusilier.
- You **must** wear the "Security Team" T-shirt distributed by the Bolder Boulder Race security leaders.
- Make sure you bring a hat and sun-block lotion. If rain is predicted on Memorial Day, bring a jacket as well.
- Water will be provided to the security team, but you may wish to bring your own water bottle.
- We will continue doing our job of making sure runners are in the proper wave though the end of all runners being started at around 9:30 a.m. Please don't leave before then.

NOTE: The Bolder Boulder Women's Elite Race begins at 11:15 a.m., with Men's Elite Race starting about seven minutes later. Our security team will not be involved in these races.

May 15 Foothills Donations Committee Meeting Notes

- 1) Request from Joe Girard (Foothills Tuition Scholarship Committee Chair) for two \$500 2013 Foothills Kiwanis Tuition Scholarship "second-place awards" to be given to deserving local-area high school seniors who were very close in service/academics to our 2013 award winner -- COMMITTEE RESPONSE: Approved by all Committee members --Adam will take an electronic vote of the Board today Wednesday May 15. Joe will be notified as soon as possible to pass along to the respective high school counselors for their Senior Awards ceremony.
- 2) Request for Foothills Boulder Foundation donation support of Boulder VoTech scholarships -- COMMITTEE RESPONSE: On May 4 our Foothills Foundation Board approved \$250 donation to the former Boulder Kiwanis Club's VoTech scholarship fund (delivered to Barbara Fink by Jerry Gilland). The Foundation Board didn't approve a request of giving \$5000 of our Foundation funds to this VoTech Scholarship Fund. The Donations Committee and Foundation Board need to understand any commitments made of Boulder Kiwanis funds to this project now within our club.
- 3) Request for Foothills Boulder Foundation donation support of Boulder Kiwanis Club's horse-riding therapy program -- COMMITTEE RESPONSE: The Committee agreed we need to find a "champion" for this project, presumably Lionel but we're not sure. This request will be tabled until Lionel gets this organized within our club. Adam will contact Lionel about providing more input to the Committee about this project.
- 4) Request for Foothills Boulder Foundation donation support of the Boulder Kiwanis Club's Amistad project -- COMMITTEE RESPONSE: The Donation Committee needs to get an accounting of how Amistad has been supported in the past before we can go ahead with funding this project. The magnitude of the \$7500 request would deplete the excess Foothills Boulder Foundation funds very quickly, which total around \$10,000 of the \$17,000 in our Foundation not assigned to our Service Dog project.
- 5) Request for Foothills Boulder Foundation donation support of the Boulder Kiwanis Club's "Nuts and Bolts" program - COMMITTEE RESPONSE: Jerry recently got a bill for "Nuts & Bolts" supplies. This bill should be forwarded by Jerry to the Golden Nuggets Kiwanis Club. In general, we need to find out if there are any funds from the Boulder Kiwanis Club's Foundation funds that are linked to the "Nuts & Bolts" project now owned by the Golden Nuggets club. The current assumption is that this is not the case.
- 6) Request for Foothills Boulder Foundation donation made by our club website's "Foundation Donations" webpage based on Foothills program speaker presentations -- COMMITTEE RESPONSE: No website requests were made since our April 9 Donations Committee meeting.
