


Snippets from Recent Club Programs

5/12/25 - Bolder Boulder

June 2, 2025

Fred Fusilier gave us a presentation on the Bolder-Boulder's history, going a way back to its inaugural in 1978 with only 2,700 registrants. They've had north of 50k most years starting in 2007, and expecting 55k this year. As volunteers working security at the starting line, we are

the first volunteers representing the event that the runners will meet. Be positive! The importance of waves – there are "pinch points" on the 10K route, and waves help to reduce clogging – and accidents.



Over 40 District clubs were represented at the conference, 11 were recognized for being chartered over 100 years!
