Snippets from Recent Club Programs

11/10/25 - The Salvation Army's Red Kettle Program

Our club member, Lt. Tania, and Capt. Miguel presented information to our members about the Angel Tree, the Kettle Kickoff Event, and Red Kettle Programs with The Salvation Army (TSA). Tania provided results of the 11/5/25 kickoff event and our 2024 bell ringing totals as \$19,535 and \$25,000 respectively. The Angel Tree will provide toys for 500 children in the Boulder and Broomfield areas. Toys will be donated at eight Walmart locations. Toys will be sorted by volunteers from November 14 - December 14; gift distribution will take place on December 16 at TSA gym. Miguel informed us that our club's bell ringing location will be at KingSoopers, Zuni and 136th. The duration will be from November 24 to December 24. Felipe and YoungLife leaders and students plan to ring on multiple Saturdays to help us fill our time slots.



11/17/25 - Matthew Celeste, Wild Bear Nature Center

Matthew is the Director of Development at Wild Bear Nature Center in Nederland, Colorado, where he has served for the past 1½ years. A Colorado native with a background in sustainable agriculture from UC Santa Cruz, Matthew has worked with other nonprofits in Boulder County including Community Food Share and Greenwood Wildlife Rehabilitation Center. At Wild Bear, he leads fundraising and development efforts to inspire a lifelong connection to community and nature through the creative exploration of the outdoors. The Wild Bear Center will open Fall 2026. Thanks, Matt, for making us aware of this new center!
