Snippets from Recent Club Programs

July 12 - Kelly Steck-James, Rocky Mountain District Governor

Kelly spoke to our club members about the recently-announced Kiwanis International "ELIMINATE" project to help prevent maternal and neonatal tetanus (MNT). MNT steals the lives of 60,000 innocent babies and 30,000 mothers each year around the world. The effects of the disease are excruciating — tiny newborns suffer repeated, painful convulsions and extreme sensitivity to light and touch. Kiwanis International and UNICEF have joined forces to eliminate this deadly disease.



(NOTE: All change collected each week in the coffee can that's passed around will go to the ELIMINATE project.) In addition, Kelly talked about new RMD Kiwanis clubs in Broomfield and Monument. Lastly, Kelly asked club members to consider attending the August 12-15 Annual Rocky Mountain District Convention in Laramie, and for the club to provide an item for the Convention's "Silent Auction" fundraiser.

July 19 – Catherine Bedell, "Crayons to Calculators" Program

Catherine Bedell spoke about the local "Crayons to Calculators" Impact on Education program that helps provide school supplies to needy kids who attend primary schools in Boulder County and St. Vrain County. She said that rather than buy school supplies to donate, it's best to **make a donation by August 7** since this program is given a price-discount for school supplies (including calculators) by Staples.
