

Snippets from Recent Club Programs

<u>8/14/23 JoAnn Joselyn – What's Happening in Sudan</u>

JoAnn gave a PowerPoint presentation on her trip to Sudan with her family in February 2023. An armed struggle broke out between two generals and their armies in February 2023. Looking back, they were warned by the State Department to not go to Sudan, and now she knows why, but they went anyway! Her family (sister and brother-in-law) wanted to go for the retirement celebration of her brother-in-law, who worked for Boston Museum specializing in Sudanese artifacts. JoAnn explained that Sudan is larger than Spain, is 40% illiterate, and Muslin country. The 4000-mile Nile runs North through Sudan and Egypt and empties into the Mediterranean Sea. They visited primarily three areas in Sudan: Jebel Barkat, Kerma and Merawag. Jebel Barkat has history back to 1450 BC, is a sacred birthplace, and worship area of gods with some small pyramids. Kerma has monuments dating to 1500 BC with no tourist accommodations; tents were used for three nights. Merawag has 19 pyramids and home to a Christian Church that dates back 1000 years. She recommended a movie, Khartoum, and Churchill's book, River War. The tour company used was Far Horizon Travel. Thanks, JoAnn, for an interesting and educational program!
