June 30 – Rita Schwarzenberger (from Nigeria), "Hope for the Village Child"

Sister Rita spoke to us about her “Hope for the Village Child Foundation” which helps needy villages in southern Nigeria through a variety of programs:

- Overall health care (immunization, growth monitoring, laboratory services, deliveries of newborns, eye testing, emergency medical treatment, care of vulnerable children)
- Rural clinics, providing health education for women and as needed immunization
- Focused medical treatment of rickets, a skeletal deformity due to lack of calcium that’s corrected with calcium pills or in some cases using surgery, as well as helping children with other diseases such as polio,
- Education, including providing textbooks, teaching materials, and desks
- Giving women a sense of empowerment through education and job training
- Clean-water development through wells and other means
- Agriculture projects that teach villagers how to grow crops better
- General community development programs that train village leaders.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: A motion was made and seconded to approve the June minutes. Report approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT: A motion was made and seconded to approve June report. Passed.

SECRETARY'S REPORT: A motion was made and seconded the June minutes be approved. Report approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT: A motion was made and seconded the June Foundation Treasurer's report be approved. Passed.

NEW BUSINESS: After discussion, a motion was made to open a new checking account for the Dog Project account to simplify Club accounting. Passed.

--A motion was made to give the budgeted \$1500 to Sprenkle for the National Softball Tournament. Approved.

--An explanation was given and discussed regarding confusion and complications regarding Ball's matching funds for the Golf Tourney.

--Gilland reported a net \$10,819 from the Golf Tourney. A motion was made to add \$181 from the Foundation to make an even \$11,000 for project distributions. Approved.

--A motion to distribute The Golf Tourney proceeds per budget were: Attention Homes, \$1,000 (already paid); Project Eliminate \$2,000 and the Dog Service Project \$8,000. Approved.

--A motion was made for Rogers to present a \$1,000 check to the District at the District Convention August 7-9. Approved. Rogers will obtain a plum colored District Foundation jacket for Pauluhn from the Club's contribution.

The Kiwanis Foundation Board Meeting adjourned at 8:22.
