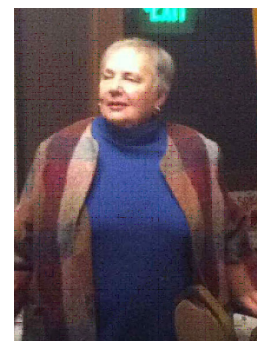

Snippets from Recent Club Programs

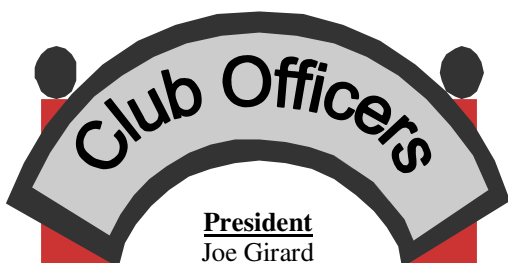
March 28– Tania Leontov, "FOCUS" Offender Reentry Program

The FOCUS re-entry program assists individuals released from prison in getting their life back and live healthy, productive lives. Tania Leontov and one the programs participants spoke to our club about the difficulty that convicts have overcoming the obstacles of finding self-worth after leaving prison. Her guest shared with us his story of addiction and family troubles. Thanks to the FOCUS program, where he met regularly with a sponsor who supported him through every step of finding a job and fighting addiction, he was able to re-connect with his family, find work, and self-respect. Board of Directors Meeting- March 31, 2011
