Snippets from Recent Club Programs

1/15/24 – President Bill and club meeting – Formant and Dues moving Forward

President Bill (and to some extent the board) presented a recommended club format going forward. The following were approved by unanimous vote of members present.

- (1) We will meet on three times per month, on the first 3 Mondays of each month (* - some adjustment for holidays will be adopted);
- (2) The first meeting will be a board meeting – of course all members are invited to attend.
- (3) Meals will be at member expense.
- (4) A single caraffe of coffee will be available for board meetings; a 2nd will be purchased for regular meetings in the event we run out and there is interest in more quaffing
- (5) Dues will be reduced to \$81 per quarter (Jan, Apr, July and Oct). This is retroactive to January 1, 2024.



As some expenses are currently hard to pin down (new member fees, conventions support), the board will revisit the dues amount later in the year, no later than August as part of the 24-25 budget process.
