## Snippets from Recent Club Programs

### 6/17/19 – Katy Voldrich, Community Food Share

Katy Voldrich is Volunteer Manager at Community Food Share. The organization’s mission is to eliminate hunger in Boulder and Broomfield Counties. She explained that Community Food Share was created as a non-profit organization in 1981, receiving a seed grant from what is now Foothills United Way, and became an affiliate of America’s Second Harvest (now called Feeding America). Originally operating under the umbrella of Food Bank of the Rockies, Community Food Share began operations in a space at EFAA’s ECHO House Emergency Shelter. Shortly thereafter, the City of Boulder offered space in a city-owned building on 13th Street. Immediately, Community Food Share began collecting and distributing food to 18 human service agencies in Boulder County. In 2013 Community Food Share moved to a renovated 70,000 square foot facility in Colorado Technology Center in Louisville. Katy informed us that there are many volunteer activities for individuals. ### 6/24/19 – Jeff Blumenfeld, Author of Travel With Purpose

Jeff Blumenfeld is founder and president of Blumenfeld and Associates PR, LLC, a public relations and adventure marketing agency based in Boulder. Clark Morrell, Treasurer of the Foundation since 2017, spoke to us about the 501c3 charitable arm of the the RMD Kiwanis Foundation. Clark grew up in Washington, D.C. area. He was US Army officer, and received an MBA from Stanford University. He moved to Colorado in 1983 and worked for Coors Brewing for 25 years in Finance and Mergers & Acquisitions. He was a member of Blue Spruce Kiwanis serving as President and Treasurer. He is currently with Arvada Jefferson Kiwanis, and has served as President and is current Treasurer of this club. He explained that every Kiwanian is a member of the Foundation. There are 13 members on the Board of Directors. They raise about \$45k each year for Kiwanis projects in the district. The largest recipient is Ronald McDonald House (Denver, Colorado Springs, and Grand Junction) that houses families of children at Children's Hospital.
