## Snippets from Recent Club Programs

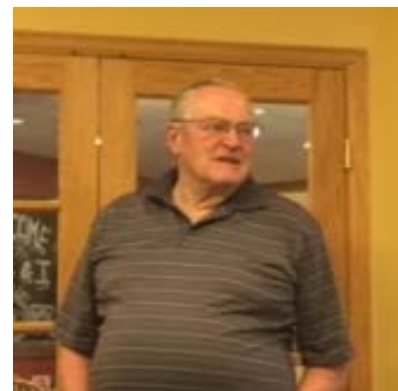
### July 31 – Dr. Bill Lucius, Blanding Red Ware Update

Dr. Lucius and his wife, Irene Lopez-Wessell, began the Blanding Red Ware Project in 2000. The project was designed to locate the production zones where potters made a distinctive orange pottery during the Pueblo I period (A.D. 750-900) of the ancestral Pueblo occupation of the Northern Southwest. After four years of fieldwork, Geoscientist Steven Di Naso came on board to add an archaeometric focus to our sourcing analysis research. Bill informed us how they finally managed to develop an approach to linking archaeological sherds to the individual clay sources used for making orange pottery. He showed a slide that illustrates how it is possible to map the direction and distance each sherd travelled from where it was made to where it was found. Bill and his team have identified 661 sites with sherds. Their research showed that some pots travelled over 400 km by gift exchanges. Thanks, Bill and Irene, for sharing information on the Native American tribes located in the Mesa Vera area!



### August 7 – Rudi Baumann, Travelogue Amsterdam to Bucharest

Rudi, a charter member of our club, highlighted the 24-day trip that Sharon and he took in May 2015. This Tauck tour started in Amsterdam and concluded, after 64 locks, in Bucharest. The tour took them through the Netherlands, Germany, Austria, Croatia, Romania, and Bulgaria. Highlights included castles, the Lorelei, Melk Abby, ballet, palaces, and Tito's Square. The river boat carried 118 passengers. He recommends this mode of travel as they never had to unpack or pack their bags. Again, Rudi recommends flying business class for addition legroom, and all-inclusive service on smaller ships. Rudi states that "someday is now" - never postpone travel to the destination of your choice. Thanks, Rudi, for the interesting travelogue!
