## Snippets from Recent Club Programs

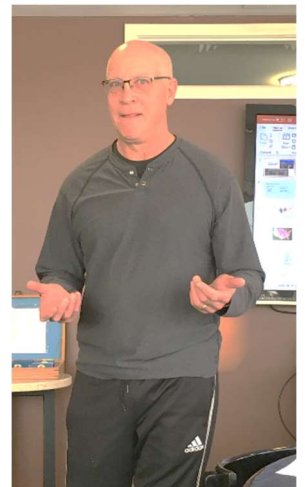
### 2/10/20 – Major Mike Paugh, The Salvation Army Red Kettle Results

Major Mike presented the results of our 2019 Red Kettle campaign. He started out by saying that we had 24 fewer days in 2019 to ring the bell, and that the Intermountain Region was down in contributions received. In 2018 combined giving for Boulder and Broomfield was (\$43k+\$100k) = \$143k. In 2019 combined giving was (\$54k+\$121k) = \$175k. Our Kiwanis Club brought in \$16,803. This equates to \$669/day, or \$83.62/hour. Our club has won the **FIRST-PLACE** bell ringing trophy for the year 2019! Annette, who coordinated signups for our club, accepted the “heavy” trophy with the help of President Craig. Thanks to our Corps Officers and Staff, all our club members, and friends of the club who raised funds to help the needy in our community!



### 2/17/20 – Joe Girard, Story Telling

Joe told us of his approach in putting together a story. He used the analogy of a rope with its many fibers and having to decide which thread to begin with and how many to use. Next, he gave us many threads of a story he is currently working on that include: 1) America’s West, 2) St. Louis Three Flags Day in 1804, 3) Transfer of Upper Louisiana from Spain to France to US, 4) Lewis & Clark Expedition, 5) Cabeza de Vaca & Coronado Travel 1804-06, 6) Pierre Joliet Expedition, 7) William Ogden’s vision of canal from Great Lakes to Mississippi River, 8) Erie Canal completion in 1825, 9) St. Louis’ rapid growth (Queen City of the West), 10) US canal surge (1800-50), and 11) Chicago’s waterway and its tremendous growth. This Chicago story brought back memories of Marilyn and me taking a waterway cruise through Chicago to see the architectural sites and buildings of downtown Chicago. I look forward to Joe’s story. ## 2/10/20 - The Salvation Army Christmas Results

Major Mike brought three staff guests from The Salvation Army to describe their respective Christmas results:

- **Belinda Salgado** – several area corporations purchased Angel Tree gifts for community children. Ball Corporation took the largest number (900 tags); their toys were delivered before Christmas to TSA using 3-4 semi-trucks.
- **Rebecca Castillo** - she started in November to sign up families that needed gifts for their children. There were 280 families with 500 children that received gifts. There are currently 23 registered children in the afterschool program. The gym is one of the many area facilities used by Broomfield police to provide the homeless with a warm area for sleeping overnight. Eight took advantage of the facility last week when temperatures dropped below 20°.
- **Major Beth** – the 100 residents of TSA’s Silver Crest independent living facility were adopted by Sierra Nevada employees who provide Christmas gifts to them. Gifts varied from games & toys, to appliances, and pet needs. SN employees were servers at their Christmas party. She explained that extra toys and clothes were provided to other area nonprofits such as Sister Carmen and Precious Child.
